*This Sunday's Gospel reminds us of Jesus' command to love our enemies. This helps us understand why God asks this of us. Jesus teaches that loving our enemies, forgiving those who hurt us, and avoiding judgment can change our hearts and the world. It's difficult but necessary.*

*By forgiving, we free ourselves from anger and become more like Christ. Remembering that God loves and forgives all, including those who have wronged us, is key.*

*Praying for someone who has wronged us can help release resentment and bring healing. By following Jesus' command to love our enemies, we open our hearts to God's grace and peace.*
