

On June 29, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul to honour the two great apostles Peter and Paul. St Peter, one of the Twelve and the chief of the Apostles, the Rock upon which Christ built His Church, and St. Paul "called to be an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God" (Romans 1:1) and Apostle to the Gentiles. Together they are honoured as founders of the Church of Rome, having been separately martyred there during the reign of Emperor Nero.

Through Saints Peter and Paul, our Lord gave his Church the foundations of her heavenly office — and through them, he helps her to eternal salvation.
