- Sundays: (8:15 & 11:00). Both Saturday Masses will **be accounted for a Sunday Mass.**

These are the regulations to follow if you intend to attend Holy Masses:

- Parishioners attending the church must bring a facial mask and wear it during Holy Mass. They must sanitise their hands when entering and leaving the church. At the conclusion of Holy Mass, please leave immediately.
- When you arrive, the stewards will assist you on the one-way system in the church and where you might sit down. Please respect where the stewards ask you to be seated – unfortunately at this time we cannot accommodate people sitting in their 'favourite' part of the church. The stewards are here to help us so please be kind & patient.
- Please remember to leave your collection in the box when entering or leaving the church – we are currently advised that the safest way for people to donate is by standing order so as to avoid handling cash.
- Due to social distance requirements space in the church is limited to 90 people. Therefore, there may be instances in which entry to the church will not be possible. *Please note that all 10:00am Masses will continue to be live streamed on St Joseph's Parish, Wealdstone Facebook account.*
