

Dear Parishioners,

For the past 2 weeks, our church has been opened for private prayer thanks to the teams of stewards and cleaners. Definitely it has been great to have the doors of the church opened and be able to pray again in the presence of Jesus in the Tabernacle.

Next week, our church will be opened to the faithful for private prayer (30 min before Mass).

Holy Masses: - Wednesday 8th July (10am)

- Thursday 9th July (10am)

- Friday 10th July (10am)

- Saturday 11th July (10am & 6pm)

- Sundays 12th July (8:15 & 11:00).

Both Saturday Masses will be those of Sunday. **The church will be open on Monday of this week, July**

6th from 3pm till 6pm, for private prayer but after that we shall not be opening for private prayer again this week.

These are the regulations to follow if we intend to attend Holy Masses:

- Parishioners who have any symptoms of the Covid 19 should refrain from attending either Private Prayer or/and Holy Mass in church.

- Parishioners attending the church must bring a facial mask and wear it during Holy Mass. They must sanitise their hands when entering and leaving the church. At the conclusion of Holy Mass, please leave immediately.

- When you arrive at the doors of the church, please wait for the stewards to assist you on the one-way system in the church and where you might sit down. Because the pews will be filled out from the front to the back.

- Due to social distance requirements space in the church is limited to 90 people. Therefore, there may be instances in which entry to the church will not be possible.

Although there seems to be too many regulations to be followed, it is important that we follow the guidance given in order to keep everybody safe. And consider that we are not going to return to the 'old' normal.

Please note that all 10:00am Masses will continue to be live streamed on St Joseph's Parish, Wealdstone Facebook account.
